

Day 6 | April 13, 2024: Medjugorje

Mount of the Cross-The Cross of the Risen Christ-Pray the Way of the Cross; visit St. James's Church-participate the Adoration of the Sacrament of the Eucharist, the blessing of healing

Day 7 | April 14, 2024: Medjugorje-Split-Zagreb

- Visit Zagreb Cathedral
- Visit Diocletian Palace
- Walk around the beautiful Croatian city of Split on the Mediterranean Sea,
- Visit_Beautiful Plitvice Lake, where 16 terraced lakes surrounded by woody mountains

Day 8 | April 15, 2024: Zagreb-Mariazell-Vienna

Visit Our Lady of Mariazell to the Life of the Kingdom of Aó Quốc

Visit St. Stephen Cathedral, it is famous for the image of Our Lady of Marypoc

Day 9 | April 16, 2024: Vienna- Czech Republic

Visit "Sedlec Ossuary Church" a unique structure in the world listed as a UNESCO Cultural Heritage because the whole church is decorated with real human bones.

Day 10 | April 17, 2024: Krakow

Krakow-Visit the Shrine of Divine Mercy

Visit the Chapel with the relics of Saint Faustina. The Holy Father visited here in 1997

Day 11 | April 18, 2024: Krakow

Visit the Black Madonna of Czestochowa

Visit the Wieliczka Salt Mine & Visit the beautiful Wieliczka Church under the lights with statues of God and statues of John Paul II made of salt because the church is in the heart of the salt mine

Day 12 | April 19, 2024: Krakow

Wadowicer- visit the homeland (especially the childhood home) of Pope John Paul II. Offer Mass in the church where he was baptized.

Day 13 | April 20, 2024: Krakow-Budapest

City Tour Budapest: visit the old town (Old Town), St. Stephen Cathedral

Cruise on the romantic Blue River (Danube) to admire the magnificent, splendid ancient castles reflected on the beautiful river surface once praised in the famous song "The Blue Danube"

Day 14 | April 21, 2024: Budapest

Travel by coach to Szentendre, known as "the artists' Village" with ancient Cathedrals and castles of a glorious time of Hungarian Catholic kings (once canonized by the Vatican). Visit Esztergom Cathedral with the largest building in Hungary (5600m²), rare and invaluable relics of the Hungarian Church.

Day 15 | April 22, 2024

St. Paul's Cathedral Outside the City

Is one of the four major papal basilicas in Rome, along with the basilicas of St. John in the Lateran, St. Peter and St. Mary the Great, as well as one of Rome's Seven Pilgrim Churches.

Vatican

With an area of 49 hectares (121 acres) and as of 2023 a population of about 764, it is the smallest state in the world in both area and population. Ruled by the Holy See, the Vatican City State is an ecclemic or clerical state-a monarchy ruled by the Pope, who is the bishop of Rome and the head of the Catholic Church.



St. John Laterano Cathedral

This is the Catholic cathedral of the Diocese of Rome in the city of Rome and the seat of the bishop of Rome, the pope.

Medjugorje

Medjugorje is a town in Bosnia and Herzegovina. This has been an unofficial Catholic pilgrimage site since the Virgin Mary is said to have appeared on Appearing Hill in 1981. There is a statue of 'Queen of Peace' marking the site of the first appearance and a statue in front of St.

James's Cathedral.

Diocletian Palace

Is an ancient palace built for the Roman emperor Diocletian in the late third century AD, today occupying about half of the ancient town of Split, Croatia.



Mariazell Church

Is a Roman Catholic church building in Mariazell, Austria. It is the most important Christian pilgrimage destination in Austria and one of the most visited temples in Europe. In the church, a wooden miraculous statue of the Virgin Mary is venerated.

dedicated to devotion to Divine Mercy, and
the resting place of Faustina Kowalska,
canonized by the Catholic Church on April
30, 2000

Wadowice

Wadowice is known as the birthplace of Karol Wojtyła, later Pope John Paul II



Szentendre

Is a Hungarian town on the Danube, north of Budapest. It is known for its baroque architecture, churches, colorful houses and narrow cobbled streets.

- 30 days before the departure date, cancellation fee 50% penalty
